Rizwhan Suleman Chiropractor, Colon Hydrotherapist, Hijama Therapist & Instructor.

He completed a Colorectal Fellowship in St George Hospital, Sydney, Australia. Paul uses laparoscopic colorectal surgery for both benign and malignant conditions affecting the colon, rectum and anus as well as training medical practitioners in advanced surgical techniques. His main interest is in the treatment of benign anorectal conditions, including haemorrhoids as well as Colorectal cancer.

Roger Groos - ARCH President. National College of Colon Hydrotherapy Tutor.

Roger will follow on from Paul Mackay's lectures and discuss Naturopathic and Colon Hydrotherapy treatment protocols for the conditions covered on this day.

Dr Anthony Hobson. Anthony is an internationally renowned Consultant Clinical Scientist with experience across the NHS and private healthcare sectors as well as in academia and the pharmaceutical industry. Anthony trained in Manchester and gained a broad base of experience in assessing gut function from 'top to bottom' covering areas such as gastro-oesophageal reflux disease, Irritable Bowel Syndrome (IBS), incontinence and constipation. Anthony's industry experience provided further training in designing and implementing clinical trials to test experimental approaches and novel treatments in conditions like IBS.
